

Meet report: July 2nd at MSAC Short Course Qualifying Meet

Sale Swimmers continue to see their PB's tumble.

A team of 8 travelled to Melbourne to compete at the North-West Aquatic State Qualifying Meet on Saturday 2nd July with improved performances in the pool and further State and Country Short Course times achieved.

Shaylee Wedlock had an excellent meet swimming in 7 races achieving PB's in all with **State times in 50/100/200 Free, 100 Breast and 100 I.M.**

Meanwhile little sister **Kiana** shaved .73 off her 50 Backstroke and swam very well in her 50 Free and Breast. What a neat surprise to win the spot prize of a pair of new goggles!

Congratulations to **Chloe Haylock** adding the 100 free to her Country short course list, she swam in three races with PBs in all.

Megan Keil has continued her good start to the season with another **State time in 100 Breast and also a PB in 100 free.**

Emily Morrison swam very strongly in five races finishing **1st 50 Free and 100 Backstroke, 2nd 100 IM , 3rd 100 Free and 4th Open 200 Backstroke.** Along the way she had 3 Pb's and added the 200 BK to both her Country and State times.

Stephanie Poland swam strongly achieving 5 PB's in her 5 events, finishing with a **state/country time for 100 IM** and coming within 0.1 and 0.3 of a state time in the 100 Backstroke and 50 free respectively.

Joshua Tatterson swimming in a big program of 6 events continued his great start to the season with PB's in all events - most notable being 2.93 off 50 free and 4.72 off 200 free.

Samuel Tatterson swimming in his first meet of the season finished the day with some very strong swimming resulting in PB's in all races. He improved his 50 **Br country time swimming a 49:15.**
